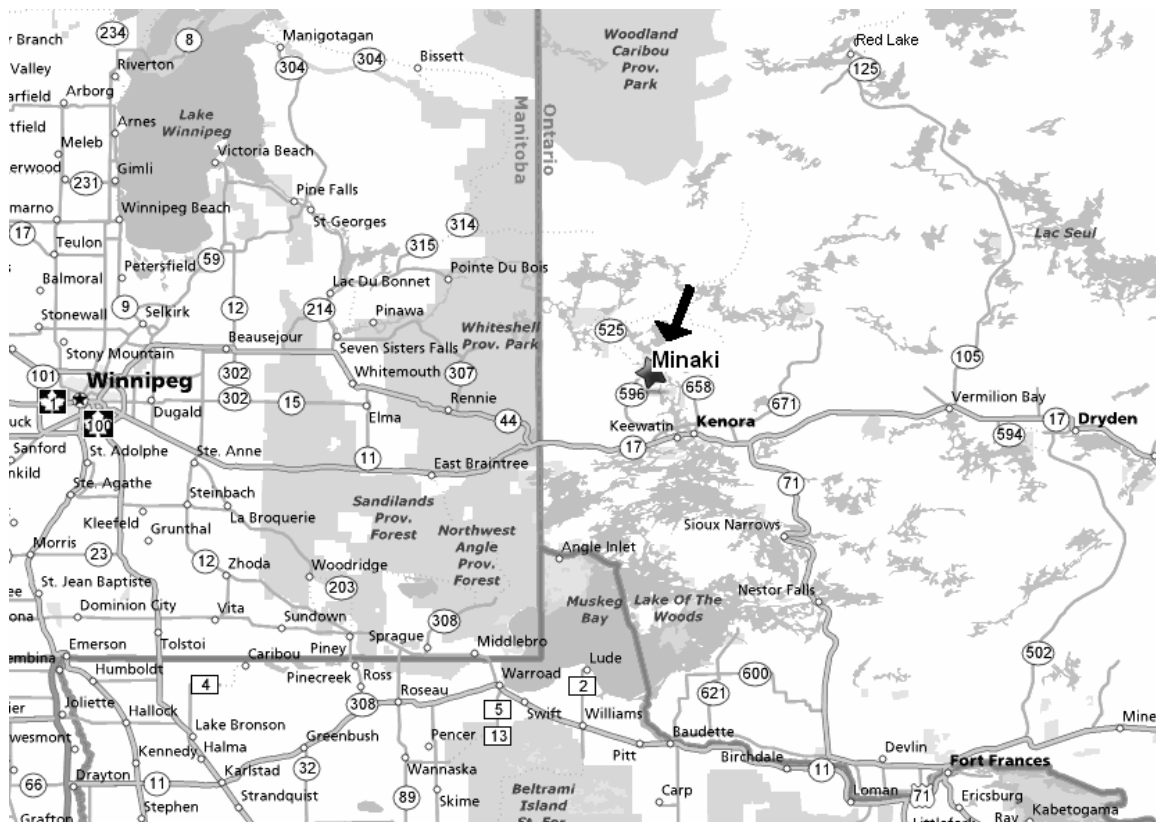

GENERAL RULES

- All persons 18 years or older are eligible to enter. Anglers under the age of 18 must fish with parent or guardian.
- Only walleye, sauger & saugeye 35-45 centimeters will be accepted by tournament officials, with one fish over 70 centimeters allowed.
- Daily limit per team shall be four (4) fish. At no time shall there be more than four (4) fish in the live well. (No more than four (4) fish per team per day)
- Live wells must be used by all teams, live well is a covered aerated container used to retain live fish.
- Tournament boundaries are The Winnipeg River and connected lakes from Norman Dam in Kenora to the Whitedog Dam. (5 Lakes)
- Tournament hours are 8:00am to 4:00pm and the Weigh-in will be open at 9:00am and will continue throughout the fishing day.
- All measurements will be taken with the tail laid flat and pinched and the mouth closed. (Jaw not in extended position)
- If a contestant submits a fish that is judged to be within the slot limits illegal size, the contestant will be disqualified for that day's weight.
